# MASON DEVELOPMENT CENTER LOCAL CONTEST 2018

The BAC Local 3 Apprentice Contest was held at the Mason Development Center on April 21, 2018. There were 34 competing apprentices from across the four trades. The competition was intense as apprentices battled for a chance to win tools, free dues and a chance to advance to the Western States Apprentice Contest.

The bricklayer project consisted of a rectangular brick pier with a recessed panel centered on each side and a paved cap. Fourteen brick apprentices were allowed five hours to complete the project in accordance with the drawings.

PCC apprentices showcased their skills through a series of projects, that included patching damaged precast, pointing of brick with varying joint finishes, and vertical and horizontal caulking. Twelve apprentices competed and were judged on each aspect of their trade.

The Marble project was challenging with six apprentices being required to set base, wall veneer and paving in a corner configuration. There were also varying attachment details featured in this project

This was our first year holding a Terrazzo competition. Two apprentices created a floor and base project with a circle design in the center. The contest was extremely close and had to be decided by time of completion.

The contest culminated with a bar-b-q lunch from Fagundes provided by Local 3 and the Contractors Association. Prizes for contestants were provided by industry leaders Kraft Tool, DM Figley, Marshalltown, JagClamp, and Crick Tool. Congratulations to all competitors and our top finishers from each trade.

Special thanks to our judges for a job well done thank you for your commitment to apprenticeship, Armando Diaz, Marty Speger, Mark Taylor, Mark Patterson, Derek Carden, Jose Vidrio, Chuck Woodard, Pete Kruckowitz, Dave Filippi, and Randy Gyrion.
