BALLOT MEASURES

CITY OF SAN BRUNO

MEASURE F

To preserve funding for general city services, shall the city of San Bruno approve an ordinance Amending the San Bruno Municipal Code to increase the transient occupancy tax rate from ten (10%) to twelve (12%) per cent on the rent charged to hotel guests within the city.

CITY OF BRISBANE

MEASURE G

Shall the existing transient occupancy tax on the rent charged for use of hotel rooms in the city be increased from 10% to 12%?

CITY OF BURLINGAME

MEASURE H

Shall the City of Burlingame approve an ordinance amending the Burlingame Municipal Code to increase the transient occupancy tax rate from ten (10%) per cent to twelve (12%) per cent on the rent charged to hotel guests within the City?

CITY OF MILLBRAE

MEASURE J

Shall the ordinance adopted by the City Council increasing the uniform transient occupancy tax from ten (10%) per cent to twelve percent (12%) percent be approved?

CITY OF SAN MATEO

MEASURE L

Shall the city of San Mateo be authorized to enact a one-quarter cent tax on sales for eight years, with all proceeds placed in the City’s General Fund with independent annual financial audits?

Shall the City of San Mateo be authorized to increase the Hotel Transient Occupancy Tax (the hotel tax) by 2% with all proceeds placed in the City’s General Fund?

Shall Ordinance No. 2346 be adopted to increase the rates of Redwood City's Business License Tax by 16.67% per year (rounded to the nearest whole dollar amount) for each of the three successive fiscal years commencing on July 1, 2010; and then, commencing on July 1, 2013 and annually thereafter, be increased based upon the annual change in the consumer Price Index?
