## **Ballot Measures – Proposition Information**

---

**Prop 1: Veterans and Affordable Housing Bond Act - **SUPPORT – VOTE YES****  
(Authorizes \$4 Billion in Bonds to fund specified housing assistance programs)

**Prop 2: No Place Like Home Act - **SUPPORT – VOTE YES**** (Authorizes bonds to fund existing housing programs for individuals with mental illness)

**Prop 3: Bonds for Water Supply Projects – **SUPPORT - VOTE YES****  
(Authorizes \$8.9 Billion in bonds to fund water supply and quality projects, watershed, fish, wildlife, water conveyance, and groundwater sustainability and storage)

**Prop 4: Children’s Hospital Bond Act of 2018 – **SUPPORT – YES**** (Authorizes \$1.5 billion in bond funds for the construction, expansion, renovation, and equipping of certain hospitals that treat children)

**Prop 5: Changes Requirements for Home Owners to Transfer Property – **OPPOSE – VOTE NO**** (Changes requirements for certain property owners to transfer their property tax base to replacement property)

**Prop 6: Repeal of SB 1 Transportation Revenues – **STRONGLY OPPOSE – VOTE NO**** (Eliminates road repair and transportation funding. Requires fuel taxes and vehicle fees to be approved by voters)

**Prop 7: Daylight Savings Time – **OPPOSE – VOTE NO**** (The Legislature, with a 2/3 vote, could change daylight saving time if the change is allowed by the federal government. Absent any Legislative change, California would maintain its current daylight-saving time-period. Early March to early November)

**Prop 8: Authorizes Regulation of Dialysis Clinics. Limits charges - **SUPPORT – VOTE YES**** (Kidney dialysis clinics would have their revenues limited by a formula and could be required to pay rebates to certain parties {Primarily Health Insurance Companies} that pay for Dialysis treatment)

**Prop 10: Repeal of Costa Hawkins - **OPPOSE – VOTE NO**** (Expands local governments' authority to enact rent control on residential property)

**Prop 11: Rest Period Takeaway - **OPPOSE – VOTE NO**** (Requires private sector emergency ambulance employees to remain “on-call” during work breaks and eliminates employer liability)

**Prop 12: Prevention of Cruelty to Farm Animals Act - **NEUTRAL**** (Establishes new requirements on famers to provide more space for egg-laying hens, breeding pigs and calves raised for veal. California businesses would be banned from selling eggs or uncooked pork or veal that came from animals housed out of compliance)
